



CONI (Care of the Next Infant) – Information for GP records

CONI is a programme that provides support for families who have experienced or are at higher risk of **sudden infant death** (SIDS) or sudden and unexpected baby death, and who are expecting/have given birth to a new baby.

CONI support includes:

- Movement (breathing) monitor
- Daily symptom diary
- Free Baby Check APP – symptom assessment tool
- Sheffield weight chart – to assess weight gain in babies

Any of the above may prompt parents to request advice.

The **family health visitor** offers extra visits and is the key worker with the family. In many areas the baby is offered open access to a senior **paediatrician**, to the children’s ward or clinic as per local arrangements.
